

## St. Peter's Parish Sauerkraut Supper Committee Meeting Minutes

July 5, 2022

Open with prayer Our Father

1. Results from parish questionnaire discussed. Parishioners were surveyed for their choice of form of dinner for Sauerkraut supper this year, either carry-out only or carry-out with limited indoor seating, and how many were willing to help. Slightly more were in favor of carry-out only. Numbers willing to help seemed insufficient to have sit-down option.
2. A motion was made for Carry-out dinners only by Deb Leis. It was seconded by Chris Pundzak. The motion carried 7-1.
3. The committee would like to return to seated option but agreed we needed to campaign earlier to convince people to commit to help.
4. Carry-out price was raised to \$15, and raw kraut will be \$5/2.5 lb. A motion was made to raise the dinner price to \$15 by Deb Leis and seconded by Mary Filla. The motion carried unanimous. Pam to order cabbage.
5. Need to know information to put in Catholic Times by July 8:
  - a. St. Peter's Parish-Middle Ridge, Hwy. 33
  - b. Date—October 12, 2022. Time was discussed. A motion was made by Pete Benzing to have the dinner time to be 3:30 pm to 7:30 pm and seconded by Chris Pundzak. The motion carried 7-1.
  - c. Form of dinner—drive-through carry-out only
  - d. Other activities—raffle. Possible bake sale in ball park. To be discussed later.
  - e. What serving and price—sauerkraut and pork, Polish sausage, mashed potatoes and gravy, glazed carrots, homemade pie. No applesauce, cheese, or bread. In addition, sell extra raw kraut for \$5/container (2.5 lb).
6. Logistics
  - a. Handle traffic/parking as last year with overflow parking in lots across hwy.
  - b. Two lines, curbside service
  - c. No reservations
  - d. Make same amount of food and kraut (1000 lb. cabbage) as last year
  - e. Sign-up sheet in church earlier

- a. Inventory/Shopping—Mary, Deb, Pam
  - b. Ordering paper goods---LaVonne, Deb
  - c. Advertising—Pam. Article in paper—Mary. Facebook—Rachel. Website—Chris.
  - d. Traffic/parking—Tom, Pete
8. Raffle tickets. Change to 3/book. Sell \$5 each or 3/\$10. Prizes: 1<sup>st</sup>--\$300, 2<sup>nd</sup>--\$150, and 3 \$50 prizes. Find out if quilt is available. Each family 5 books.

- a. Make kraut (Aug. 9, 2022) at 5:30 pm
  - b. Make coffeecakes? Clean garage. (Sept. 24, 2022)
  - c. Supper (Oct. 12, 2022) 3:30-7:30 pm
10. Next meeting—August 9, 2022 after kraut cutting.
