Secretary's Report from July 7, 2025 meeting accepted as read.

Treasurer's Report accepted as read. Current checking balance: \$24,157.14. Current Savings balance: \$5341.87. July 2025 \$5000.00 donated towards basement floor project.

Old Business:

Sauerkraut Supper financial report. Total income \$23,791.00. Total expenses \$7,657.42 – cost of milk cartons. Net profit \$16,133.58 – cost of milk (~\$120.00, have not received bill). See Nov. 16, 2025 bulletin for details.

Sauerkraut Supper review. Two carry-out lines worked well. Need 3 people/line + 1 cashier + 2 packers = 9 people total for carry-outs. Need more people right away for carrying food between church and garage. Bake sale in tent worked well, may need to adjust location of music, bar, baked goods. New basement floor and lights in. Basement paint discussion tabled.

Motion by Deb L. to give half proceeds to Warming Center in La Crosse and half to Cashton Cupboard. Seconded by Mary F. All in favor.
